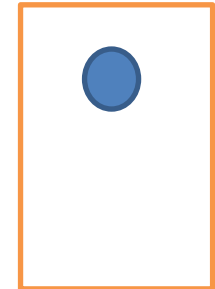
As you will see, we have made efforts to ensure that our garden remains a place of calm and respect and that we take our maintenance commitments seriously.

You are welcome to have a commemorative tablet installed in line with the following guidelines which are designed to ensure that we can meet the high standards of appearance that you will be

expecting, whilst allowing us to comply with our Diocesan requirements.

**Memorial Tablet** –York Stone of the following dimensions:-

12 inches wide  
18 inches long  
2 inches thick  
With suitable inscription in black  
(Include Hole for flowers/plants if required)



We would not encourage the use of moveable objects or memorials which would pose a risk to our health and safety conditions, nor would we encourage the use of imitation or plastic flowers which may detract from the overall standards of appearance which we feel sure you would expect.

You are also welcome to have details of your loved ones entered into our All Saints Book of Remembrance which is kept inside our church and displayed on a month by month basis.

We also offer you the opportunity to attend one of our special Services of Remembrance and Thanksgiving, along with others who have been bereaved, and who appreciate the opportunity to commemorate a loved one.
