1) Dial 02076 608149 (and that's a normal UK toll)

2) The voice says: 'Enter your access code or meeting number followed by a hash': you enter 1639950663#

3) The voice says 'Enter your attendee ID or numeric password followed by the hash sign': you just enter #

Check your phone tariff beforehand, it's a London number, with free calls often just the first hour is free.
